



Did you know that?

Women hold just about **one-fourth of decision-making positions** related to climate change in the public sector. To mitigate climate change, more effective policies and inclusive decision-making are needed.

In 2012, the **European Institute for Gender Equality** reviewed the area 'Women and the Environment' focusing on gender equality and climate change and proposed new indicators: women's participation in climate change decision-making, and the proportion of women as tertiary graduates in scientific and technical fields. This leaflet introduces you to EIGE studies and research, as well as to the vast collection of resources in its Resource & Documentation Centre.

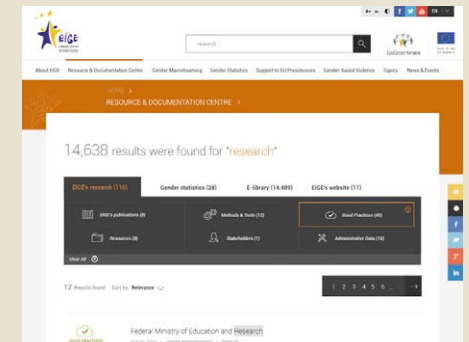
